


THIS Week...

This week we're talking about clothing ourselves with compassion, kindness, humility and patience.

- TODAY'S BIBLE VERSES: Colossians 3:12, 1 Samuel 16:7, Colossians 3:23
- EY WORDS: compassion, kindness, humility and patience
- BEFORE today's lesson:
 - Make sure you have all the materials you need for the 'Welcome Zone' and 'Fun Zone' activities.
 - Gather together all the required ingredients for 'Grub Zone'.
 - Have enough Kidzone magazines for every child!

When preparing you program, consider each of the 'zones' and how they will best work in your context.

You may like to mix up the order in which you do the 'zones'. You will, however, need to remember the 'Welcome Zone' needs to start the session, the 'Zone In' section needs to follow the 'God Zone', and the 'Beyond the Zone' happens at home.





PLAY the dress-up chocolate game.

You need a large block of chocolate, knives and forks for each player, two dice, an assortment of accessories (e.g. hat, scarf, sunglasses). The first player rolls the dice to try to get a double six. If they do get a double six, they must put on all the accessories before using the butter knife and fork to cut a square of chocolate. The player can only cut and eat one piece at a time. They continue cutting and eating the chocolate until someone else gets a double six. That player then puts on the accessories and has a turn to cut and eat the chocolate. The game is over when all the chocolate is eaten.

- MAKE Cheffy's button biscuits on page 10.

 If you don't have access to an oven, an alternative is to provide round biscuits, coloured icing and mini M&Ms for the children to decorate to look like buttons.

DISCUSS what Colossians 3:12 means.

"You are the people of God; he loved you and chose you for his own. So then, you must clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience."

- CHAT about how they can show these qualities in daily life how can they be patient and kind, what does it mean to be compassionate, gentle?
 - Explain what humility is such as to accept and apologise for mistakes, to understand that everyone has equal worth etc.
- TALK about how Jesus showed these qualities.
- GIVE OUT the 'Beyond the Zone' cards and read through the activities.
