

This week we're talking about Jesus being born in a stable.

TODAY'S BIBLE VERSES: Luke 2:1-7, John 3:16

KEY WORDS: Jesus, stable, nativity, king

BEFORE today's lesson:

- Make sure you have all the materials you need for the 'Welcome Zone' and 'Fun Zone' activities.
- Gather together all the required ingredients for 'Grub Zone'.
- Have enough Kidzone magazines for every child!
- Print off the 'Beyond the Zone' card.

When preparing yol program, consider each of the 'zones' and how they will best work in your context.

You may like to mix up the order in which you do the 'zones'. You will, however, need to remember the 'Welcome Zone' need to start the session, the 'Zone In' section needs to follow the 'God Zone', and the 'Beyond the Zone' happens at home.

READ the message.

READ Luke 2:1-7 from a children's Bible or a Bible story book.

"Jesus was a very special baby, but he wasn't born in a palace, a hospital or even a fancy house. Joseph and Mary were travelling and there were no lovely motel rooms or guest houses available. So, Jesus was born in a stable. Instead of a cot or cradle, lesus slept in a manger (the food box for the animals). Can you imagine how dirty and smelly it must have been in that stable, with all of the animals around? God could have arranged for Jesus, his Son, the King, to be born anywhere, but he wanted us to understand that he cares about all people, not just the rich or powerful. God chooses to be close to ordinary people in an ordinary way. He shows that he loves everyone, no matter who we are or what we have (or don't have). God chooses to be close to you." (From The Salvation Army Family Advent Devotional Guide).

DISCUSS why you think God chose Jesus to be born in a stable rather than in an expensive hotel. Everyone – whether rich or poor – matters to God. What can we do to show people they matter to God and to us?

PRAY: Dear Jesus, thank you for choosing to come to Earth and live as a human. Thank you for giving up Heaven to be close to us and to understand us. Help us to be willing to go to the places where people need love and help - even if it is uncomfortable for us. Amen. (From The Salvation Army Family Advent Devotional Guide).
