- OO the puzzle or the colouring competition on page 13.
- READ the story on pages 4 and 5.
- © CHAT about various chores the kids do what is one they would like a robot to do instead of them?









What don't they like about the chore? You could give an example to start the conversation – such as pulling out weeds. Maybe you don't like bending over because it hurts your back. Wouldn't it be great to have a robot to do it?

READ the message at the end of the story.

Think back to the chores they and you mentioned. For instance, maybe if you pull out weeds for five or 10 minutes a day instead of a big hour-long effort, the job would be done without your back getting sore.
