PLAY photo freeze.

This is a twist on statues: play some music and when it stops, the children freeze for you to pretend to take a photo of them.



MAKE tropical fruit kebabs.

Either get the children to cut up the 'soft' fruit, such as watermelon, kiwi fruit etc., into big chunks or provide cut fruit for them to thread onto skewers. Pour over some chocolate topping - yum!



THIS ACTIVITY COULD FOLLOW ZONE IN.

- CREATE Oliver's junk journal on page 11. (If you have some, spray adhesive will speed up the drying time.) Put together the pages.
- **READ** the message.
- MAKE title pages.

You could suggest the children write and decorate the Bible verse from the message as the front page of their journal – 1 Chronicles 16:34.



- READ Samuel's mega puzzle on page 14.
- READ a story from the Old Testament and one from the New Testament.
- 00 the puzzle or colouring comp on page 13.
- LOOK at the comic on pages 4 and 5.
- CHAT about photo albums or photo books.

You could bring in one of your own to show the children. If you are a collector of items

such as tickets or other memorabilia of activities and places you've visited, bring that in to show the children, too.

What do they think is great about having albums of photos or memorabilia?

- LOOK at page 7 at the photos of the Salvo family fun day at Brunswick. What a great way to remember a great time!
- READ the Bible message at the end of the comic.
- PRAY: Thank you God for our family and friends and the memories we create with them.
