THIS Week...

This week we're talking about keeping our eyes on Jesus.

TODAY'S BIBLE VERSES: 1 Peter 4:10, Hebrews 12:2, Matthew 11:28, Romans 12:15, Philippians 2:14

KEY WORDS: patience, following Jesus, good sports

BEFORE today's lesson:

- Make sure you have all the materials you need for the 'Welcome Zone' and 'Fun Zone' activities.
- Gather together all the required ingredients for 'Grub Zone'.
- Have enough Kidzone magazines for every child!

When preparing your program, consider each of the 'zones' and how they will best work in your context.

You may like to mix up the order in which you do the 'zones'. You will, however, need to remember the 'Welcome Zone' needs to start the session, the 'Zone In' section needs to follow the 'God Zone', and the 'Beyond the Zone' happens at home.



WELCOMEZONE^{kz}

(5-7 mins)

SET UP a simple golf game, such as the simple putting game on **page 12**, for your class to play. You'll use this game as a prop to illustrate the point being made in **GOD ZONE**.

GRUBZONE^{kz}

(5-7 mins)

READ the story on **pages 4 and 5**, finishing with the message.

CREATE Cheffy's golf green cookies on **page 10**. Yummy!

FUNZONE^{kz}

(10-15 mins)

MAKE Oliver's miniature golf putting course.

To complete this craft more quickly, you could make this a group activity, with two or three children doing different tasks at the same time.

PLAY the course!

READ the Bible message at the end of **page 9**.

CHAT about how the children went with their putting.

Was it as easy as they thought it would be? Which was harder – the game with the bucket and golf club or the miniature golf putting course? Did they improve as they played more shots? Did they find that if they concentrated, and kept their eyes on the hole, they did better?

PLAY a shot with the putting game set up in the welcome part of the session.

Show what happens if you don't look at what you're doing – the ball goes anywhere. Show the difference when you look at where you're putting the ball.

READ the message on **page 12**.

CHAT about how we keep our eyes on Jesus when we can't see him.

CHAT about how they went with playing their golf games.

Did they feel frustrated when the ball didn't go in the hole? Did it make them want to give up if they just couldn't hit the ball in? How did they feel if their friends were better at playing than them?

READ the message on **page 11** on being a good sport!



DO the Bible code puzzle on **page 14**.



GIVE OUT the 'Beyond the Zone' cards and read through the activities.
